Requesting a COVID-19 Vaccine	
1	Visit www.keystoneruralhealth.com – add your details: name, email address, phone number, qualifications etc.
1	Complete the COVID-19 Vaccination Request Form, then submit
1	You have now been added to our COVID-19 vaccine calling list!
Scheduling Your Appointment	
	Once you received a call from our staff you will choose an appointment time — Please note that your second dose of Moderna COVID-19 vaccine will be scheduled for 28-days from your first dose. Please make sure both dates work for you before booking your first dose. – Have your insurance cards ready for your scheduling call.
Preparing for Your Appointment	
	Bring your identification with you to your appointment
	You will receive text message alerts reminding you of your upcoming vaccine appointment
	Wear a short sleeve shirt or loose-fitting shirt under your coat/ jacket
At the Time of Your Appointment **Masks Required**	
	Please have your appropriate identification ready for our staff.
	When arriving to our facility be sure to call upon arrival. One of our staff members will come to your vehicle to assist you into the facility. Once inside, you will fill out paperwork, receive your vaccine, wait 15 minutes to make sure you do not have an adverse reaction, and then you are free to leave once the nurse instructs you to do so.
After Your Appointment	
	Call the office immediately after you leave to schedule your 2 nd dose – Ridgway Medical Center - 814-245-2119 Cameron County Health Care Center - 814-486-1115
	Register for v-safe (https://vsafe.cdc.gov/) to tell CDC about any side effects you are experiencing.
	Read the "Fact Sheet for Recipients and Caregivers" that was provided to you.
	Add your appointment for your second dose to your calendar.
	If you experience a severe allergic reaction, call 9-1-1, or go to the nearest hospital.
	Call the vaccination provider or your healthcare provider if you have any side effects that bother you or do not go away.
	Report vaccine side effects to FDS/CDC Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting Systems (VAERS). The VAERS tollfree number is 1-800-822-7967 or report online to https://vaers.hhs.gov/reportevent.html . Please include "Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine EUA" in the first line of box #18 of the report form.
